






### Introduction

- Heritage Park Development:
  - Commercial development planning for a new hotel and restaurant with additional space for other future commercial developments.
  - Private developers are ready for construction but are waiting on extension of public infrastructure.
- Proposed Public Infrastructure Improvements
  - New roadway, Heritage Way
  - Extension of public utilities including water & sewer
  - Drainage improvements
- Rebuild Illinois Competitive Public Infrastructure Grant
  - \$25 million allocated to fund public infrastructure improvements in accordance with Governor Pritzker's 5-year economic plan.
  - Grant awards from \$250,000 to \$5 million per project.


#### Location

• The proposed development is located between Elm St. and IL Route 9 in an undeveloped "L-shaped" property southeast of Wagoner Lanes. Site is aprx. ¼ mile east of intersection of IL Route 1 and IL Route 9 (see below)

### **Project Readiness**

- Design is complete and all necessary permits have been applied for. All permits are anticipated to be approved on or before August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
- The City has procured all necessary easements to complete the public infrastructure elements of the development and plans to review final subdivision plat this summer that would dedicate the new right-of-way for Heritage Way.
