CITY OF HOOPESTON TO CLOSE CITY HALL JANUARY 18th CITY COUNCIL MEETING WILL BE REMOTE

Due to increasing case numbers and the need to keep city workers healthy, city hall will be closed to the public beginning January 18, 2022 and will tentatively reopen on January 31, 2022.
