PURPOSE OF MEETING-CONTRACT FOR ANIMAL CONTROL

- I. MAYOR WISE CALLED THE SPECIAL MEETING TO ORDER AT 6:30 PM.
- II. ROLL CALL- The five Council members present were Eyrich, K. Ferrell, M. Ferrell, Lawson and Porth. Garrett and Highfill were absent.
- III. INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT between the CITY OF HOOPESTON and COUNTY OF VERMILION, A BODY POLITIC

The city has been without an Animal Control Officer for more than a month. Numerous incidents have occurred where an animal control officer was needed. The contract with Vermilion County would be temporary, in that the City will be able to see how the situation is working out and until another option comes up.

The monthly kennel fee is \$25, with other costs involved.

In case of a situation when animal control is needed, citizens should call 911 for extreme or emergency situations. The local police number should be called for nonemergency situations. Dispatch will contact Vermilion County.

The Agreement will run from July 19, 2023, thru the end of this fiscal year. A 30-day notice of cancellation is allowed for either party.

Eyrich moved to enter into the Intergovernmental Agreement with a second by K. Ferrell. Roll call vote was taken, and the motion was passed five to zero.
